Frontlines has a proud 33 year history as a youth charity located in York-South Weston providing a variety of programs and services to youth. Frontlines is the only child and youth specific center in Weston.

The mission of Frontlines is to address the pressing needs of children and youth of Weston and surrounding communities. We address these pressing needs of our participants through the provision of a variety of programs such as homework assistance, cooking, sports, arts and recreation programs for youth 6-12, as well as leadership, violence prevention, cooking and employment programs for youth 13-29. All our programs are accompanied by a meal because we are aware of the issues of food insecurity and poverty coupled with the fact that many single parents are not at home to prepare and partake in dinner with their children.
